Plan:

- Print out copies of the Beaver Scout promise and law
- Gather large pieces of paper and colouring pencils
- Scouters and the Lodge Leaders agree a plan

Do:

- In lodges, Beaver Scouts, with the help of Scouters, should discuss the Colony Code. The Beaver Scout promise and law can be the foundation for your ideas.
- It may help to think about grouping your thoughts into 'What We Do' and 'What We Don't Do'.
- Think about how you can use pictures and images, and practical examples.
- Scouters can gather all the ideas with the Lodge Leaders to make one code for all the Colony.
- Make a bright and colourful copy of the code to be displayed on in your meeting space.

Review:

- Discuss the Code (with examples) so that everybody understands how they can follow the code.
- Refer to the code regularly.
- Make sure that new Beaver Scouts and Scouters understand the code.
